Per Tim Spencer:-Could we discuss the possibility of reinstating the GFLBT out of Watkins Glen?

The SWLGR 2024 (former GFLBT) committee is focused on hosting the annual Finger Lakes event scheduled 8/16 - 8/18. In the fall, the committee will start planning for the 2025 event in which different locations, including Watkins Glen, will be considered. We expect to once again survey the membership about the annual event which will factor into the plan. Based on a combination of estimated attendance, event costs and volunteer support, the scaled down SWLGR event appears to be the right fit for STBC at this time. The Watkins Glen event, as it was traditionally held, required many more attendees in order for it to be a viable option for the club.
